

Price and Cancellation Policy

\$2250 + airfare. Price increases to \$2400 + airfare if reservation made after January 1, 2023

Includes:

- Transportation during the trip on a coach bus.
 - All meals or meal stipend.
 - Entrance tickets to Universal Studios, Disneyland & California Adventure, One (1) Trip t-shirt, One (1) Trip hat.
 - 6-8 Rotary chaperones
 - This is primarily tent camping. Hotel the first and last night in San Francisco, a hotel Las Vegas and tent cabins in Yosemite. Hotels and Tent camp with 4–5-person shared accommodation.
 - Tents, sleeping bags & pads will be included.
 - Hotel will provide free transportation to and from SFO airport.
- Please make your reservation by December 31, 2022.
- Trip has a limited capacity of 55.

Reservations are open for Rotary Long-term exchange students hosted in the USA and Canada until 31 December 2022 at a cost of \$2250. First come, first serve.

After 1 January 2023, the cost increase to \$2400. It is open with priority to long-term exchange students, then Rotary summer camp, and finally host siblings.

- If a trip is full, students will be placed on the Waiting List. You will be moved off the waiting list based on the date your reservation was received.
- **A trip deposit of \$300** is due within 10 days of making your reservation. The deposit will be put towards your final payment.
- Partial payments may be made.
- **The final payment is due on 1 April.**
- Each student must **submit the proper authorization forms to Western Safari by 1 April**, or the student's reservation may be canceled. Students who arrive on the trip without the proper forms submitted will not be able to participate and will be responsible for any fees associated with an early return flight.

CANCELLATION AND REFUND POLICY

There must be at least 35 students signed up to run a trip. The maximum is 55.

If we do not achieve the minimum number of participants needed, Western Safari reserves the right to cancel the trip. If this occurs, all payments already made will be returned in full.

1. If the student chooses to leave their program, is sent home for breaking any program rules, or chooses to cancel their Western Safari reservation, they will pay the penalty according to the date of their written order to cancel their tour, as described below:

*Cancelled more than 30 days before the beginning of the trip, you pay 10% of the trip's price.

*Cancelled between 29 and 21 days before the beginning of the trip, you pay 20% of the trip's price.

*Cancelled between 20 and 7 days before the beginning of the trip, you pay 40% of the trip's price.

*Cancelled between 6 days or less before the beginning of the trip, you pay 100% of the trip's price.

2. If a student cancels their trip, any payments made may be transferred to another student or host sibling.

3. Any student who leaves the trip during the program for any reason will not receive any refund.

4. Any cancellations or withdrawals must be made in writing – via email – by the tour's participant to Western Safari. After the initial request, reimbursement will be made in the same form of payment as the money was received. The reimbursement amount will be applied according to the Cancellation and Refund Policy's penalty amount (listed above).

5. Additional costs, bank fees, or taxes associated with the refund will be the client's responsibility and deducted from the reimbursement amount.

6. In case of early return of the student from the trip, the cost of the return ticket is the student's responsibility.

7. Western Safari is not responsible for any reimbursements or change fees associated with flight or travel arrangements.
